1. General Information

Transition Year is a one-year programme. It provides a bridge to enable students make the transition from Junior to Senior cycle. It encourages personal and social development and recognises the need for students to grow in independence. Transition year fosters academic achievement as students prepare for a Leaving Certificate Programme, further study and adult and working life. It encourages the development of a wide range of transferable critical thinking and creative problem-solving skills.

Transition Year.

- 1. To gain admittance to the programme students should submit a written application prior to the closing date.
- 2. When considering admission, a student's record in the school will be taken into account including;
 - Behaviour
 - Attendance
 - Suitability of that student for Transition Year.
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- 3. As places are limited not all students may be successful.
- 4. If the number of suitable applicants exceeds the number of places available admission will be decided on the basis of random selection. (The names will be entered into a hat and drawn at random).
- 5. Part of Transition Year entails forming new Tutor Groups and students must accept the Tutor Group they are allotted to.

Transition Year Fee will be a maximum of €300. Please return completed application form and initial deposit of €100, by 1.00 pm on Thursday 26th January 2023 to secure your place.
