Students Academic Potential is generated from each students entrance exam

- 1 mostly over 80% at higher/common level.
- 2 mostly 65 79% at higher/common level.
- 3 mostly 50 64% at higher/common level or over 80% at ordinary level.
- 4 mostly 30 49% at higher/common level
 or over 50 70% at ordinary level.

1 to 5 Rating Definitions

Used for rating students in Collaboration, Attitude, Enterprising and Homework

5 = Excellent - Your student always fulfils theirpotential continuously striving to achieve their best.

4 = **Very Good** - Your student usually fulfils their potential with minor scope for improvement.

3 = **Good** - Your student generally fulfils their potential but scope for improvement is evident.

2 = **Average** - Your student occasionally fulfils their potential with considerable scope for improvement.

1 = Poor - Your student rarely fulfils their potential, their is significant scope for improvement in both application and attitude.

Ongoing Assessments

Descriptor

Exceptional Consistently exceeds potential Occasionally exceeds potential Consistently meets potential Occasionally meets potential Rarely meets potential Consistently under-achieving

Example

If a student is in 1 (65 - 79%) but is only getting between 45 - 70% in their class and other assessments, their ongoing assessment rating would be Occasionally meets potential.

If a student is in 4 (30 – 49%) but is getting between 55 – 70% in their assessments, their class and other ongoing assessment rating would be Consistently exceeds potential.
