IMPORTANT POINTS FOR STUDENTS:

The Summer exams for First Years will take place in the **Sports Hall**. Students will be allocated seats, with tutor groups sitting in rows.

Only bring the books you will need to study, along with the equipment you will need-pens, pencils, ruler, calculator etc.

When the examination begins books should be closed and placed **gently** under your desk.

Students should clearly enter their name, their tutor group and year group and the subject being examined on the front of their answer booklet(s).

No food or drink is allowed in the examination centre.

Students should strive to use the time allocated for each exam correctly, students should not be finished exams with a class or more to spare.

Absolutely no communication is allowed between students. If you are caught communicating or copying your exam may be cancelled.

If a student requires assistance they should hold their hand up and wait for a teacher.

Students are encouraged to **use the toilet before school and at break times**. This is to avoid distracting other students. Students will be asked to sign out when using the toilet.

Any student refusing to abide by these rules may be removed from the exam centre and asked to remain at home for the duration of the exams.
