1 to 5 Rating Definitions Used for rating students in Collaboration, Attitude, Enterprising and Homework

- **5 = Excellent** Your student always fulfils their potential continuously striving to achieve their best.
- **4 = Very Good** Your student usually fulfils their potential with minor scope for improvement.
- **3 = Good** Your student generally fulfils their potential but scope for improvement is evident.
- **2 = Average** Your student occasionally fulfils their potential with considerable scope for improvement.
- **1 = Poor** Your student rarely fulfils their potential, their is significant scope for improvement in both application and attitude.
