FSAI Precautionary Notification

The Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) have advised people who have a peanut allergy, as a precautionary measure, to avoid consuming foods that contain mustard as they may contain peanut.

This FSAI alert is linked to contaminated mustard ingredients that have been supplied for use in the UK & Ireland. At this stage there is no evidence to indicate our Food Supply Chain is impacted by this. We are keeping it touch directly with our suppliers. And our Vendor Assurance team are keeping close to FSAI updates, and we will update you should this position change or further developments come to light.

- Foods with Taco Sauce / Mayonnaise
- Sandwiches containing Egg Mayo, Tuna Mayo, Chicken Mayo Stuffing (check labels).
