CAO Change of Mind

What you need to know

CAO = Using points

On cao.ie you are using Leaving Cert points to apply for:

Level 6, 7 & 8 courses in Universities, Institutes of Technology and other colleges.

YOU CANNOT APPLY FOR PLC COURSES ON CAO

You need 20 courses

- ▶ 10 courses Level 8 Honours Degrees
- ▶ 10 courses mix of Level 6 & 7
- HAVE YOU CHOSEN 20 COURSES TO PUT ON YOUR CAO LIST?
- HAVE YOU RESEARCHED EACH ONE OF THOSE VERY CAREFULLY?

What course to choose?

- You must have an interest in the area
- Do not judge from the title -titles can be misleadingresearch exactly what the course is about -
- Watch virtual open days they are on this month...ask all the questions – get all the information....
- If you are not interested in the subjects, you will be bored, or drop out......
- Good research and being honest with yourself at this stage helps avoid stress/ bad decisions later

Making Choices – this is so important – you must do your research

- Choose what you like and are interested in
- Start listing courses
- Check course content would you like it?
- Is it what you think it is?/ Check all modules carefully imagine yourself sitting in lectures on the topic....would it hold your interest/ would it challenge you?......is it for you?

Class Sizes - What would suit you?

- Would you study better in a big or a small group?
- Would you mix better in a bigger college or a smaller one?
- These are very important questions to ask yourself at this stage....be very honest....

Read the content and descriptions very carefully and try to imagine yourself sitting in these lectures.....is it for you?

Course Entry Requirements -

- Multimedia DCU needs a H4 in English
- Vet in UCD needs H5 in Chemistry
- Primary teaching needs H4 in Irish
- Check check check......do not assume

College Entry Requirements

Each college has its own requirements:

```
Example: Maynooth 2 or H5, 406/H7
Trinity 3H5 306/H7
TUD L8 2H5 406/H7
L6/7 506/H7
```

- Can you meet these requirements?


Check very Carefully

- Make sure you will meet the requirements
- Of the college and
- ▶ The specific **course**

ORDER OF PREFERENCE

- PREFERENCE- this means the course you really want goes in slot 1, the course you want if you did not get No. 1 goes in slot 2 and so on down to 10.
- This way you will think carefully about what you really want.
- Repeat this for the Level 6/7 list too.

So — what is the best way to fill in the courses?



Course Codes

- On your CAO form you will not write the name of the course but the code e.g.
- ▶ 1. DN200
- 2. TR 365
- ▶ 3. WD 231 etc <u>check all codes carefully</u>
- Check Alert list on www.cao.ie to see changes

ALERT LISTS

- Be sure to check the ALERT LIST on www.cao.ie for any changes to courses since your CAO booklet was published.
- Course code or name may be different
- A course may not be running
- Entry requirements may have changes
- New courses may be available

Covering all possibilities:

- Be sure you put courses with a <u>range of</u> <u>points</u> on your CAO
- Do not put only courses over e.g 300/400/500
- Include courses with lower points, just in case......
- Use the Level 6/7 list also



Record of your choices

- If you make changes to your list later be sure to record these changes too
- Remember to keep checking your email for any communication from the CAO

Offers

- You will get an offer for the highest course on your list that you have the points for
- You may get 2 offers one from your Level 8 list and one from your Level
 6/7 list – you choose which you want
- You can <u>only accept one offer</u>

They will get 2 offers – which to take?

- It seems this student wanted to study Business so they could take the TUD Business Studies Level 6 offer over the Arts offer as this allows them to study Business.
- They can use the ladder system to progress on to a level 7 or 8 course in TUD having completed 2 years – if their grades are high enough.
- This highlights the importance of the Level 6/7 list as a back up plan.

CAO Offer Timeline

- Best 6 results are converted to points
- First round offers issued after Leaving Cert. results in early August
- Round two offers follow
- Further offers until all places are filled
- (Vacant Places)
